##### D. Repairs to parts or systems resulting from unauthorized modifications made to the dehumidifier.

##### E. In Canada, travel or transportation expenses for customers who reside in remote areas.

##### F. Replacement parts or repair labor costs for units operated outside the United States and Canada.

##### G. Repairs when your dehumidifier is used in other than normal single-family household use.
