BEFORE YOU START



Set up your refrigerator

Remove tape and glue residue from surfaces before turning on the refrigerator. Choose a place near a grounded electrical outlet, allowing for clearances for ease of installation, proper circulation, and plumbing and electrical connections.



Before operating for the first time


After you remove all of the package materials, clean the inside of your refrigerator with soap and water before using it. See **CARE AND CLEANING** in your Use & Care Manual for other cleaning tips.

YOU'RE IN CONTROL



Your controls

Use the +/- buttons to set the freezer and refrigerator temperatures. Allow 24 hours for temperatures to stabilize. We recommend setting your freezer at 0°F/-18°C and your refrigerator at 37°F/3°C.



- **Freeze Boost** activates a faster rate for freezing food in the freezer.
- Cold Drink Timer quickly chills a drink inside the freezer compartment.
- 3 Press and hold **Ice Maker** for 3 seconds to turn the ice maker on/off.
- Press and hold
 for 3 seconds to enable/disable the appliance control display.
- Power Outage illuminates and an alert sounds after a power outage ends until you reset it by pressing any button.
- 6 Adjusting Temp illuminates when you press + or to change temperatures inside the refrigerator (34°F/1°C to 44°F/7°C) and freezer (-6°F/-21°C to 6°F/-15°C).
- Door Open Illuminates and alert sounds if the door is open 5+ minutes until you close the doors.

- 8 Replace Water Filter illuminates when it's time to change the filter, generally every 6 months.
- Replace Air Filter illuminates when it's time to change the filter, generally every 6 months.
- Press Water to dispense water.
- n Press **Cube** to dispense cubed ice.
- Press Crush to dispense crushed ice.
- **°F/°C** allows you to switch between Fahrenheit (°F) and Celsius (°C).
- Chill Boost helps ensure your recently purchased fresh food will stay cool at a faster rate to preserve freshness.
- Press and hold **Reset Air Filter**, after replacing the filter, to reset.
- Press and hold **Reset Water Filter**, after replacing the filter, to reset.
- Press

 to turn the dispenser light
 On and Off.

CUSTOMIZE

Your refrigerator's **CUSTOM-FLEX® TEMP DRAWER** has 5 different temperature settings, so you can customize the space for your needs.

Choose one of 4 settings for **REFRIGERATOR** mode, each with a different temperature level:

• Meat/Seafood:	• Deli/Snacks:
28°F/-2°C	37°F/3°C
• Cold Drinks:	• White Wine:
32°F/0°C	45°F/7°C

Or easily switch to the fifth setting for **Freezer** mode.

The temperature will drop to match the setting on your bottom freezer.



Changing settings is easy. Just follow these simple instructions:

- 1. Press and hold the Unlock button on the drawer's control panel for 3 seconds.
- Select a temperature setting. The Adjusting Temp indicator light will turn on and stay on until the drawer has reached the selected temperature setting — this can take a few hours.





Is it normal for my refrigerator to make noises?

To familiarize yourself with the sounds your new high-efficiency refrigerator may introduce, see the NORMAL OPERATING **SOUNDS** section of your Use & Care Manual.

Why does my refrigerator run most of the time? Is this normal?

Today's refrigerators are designed to be more energy efficient than previous models. This means they run longer cycles, or run continuously, to maintain an even temperature inside. Please note: starting a unit takes about 10 times as much energy as it does to keep it running.
