Cleaning the detergent dispenser



- to remove detergent residues and limescale from the jets inside the dispenser drawer housing.
- Replace the detergent dispenser drawer. **Useful tip:** Leave the detergent dispenser drawer slightly open to allow it to dry.

Washing at low temperatures and/or using liquid detergent can cause bacteria and unpleasant odours to build up in the washing machine. Use the Cottons 90°C programme to clean the washing machine. Clean the drum no later than the point at which the **i** indicator light and *l* light up in the time display.
