Notice:

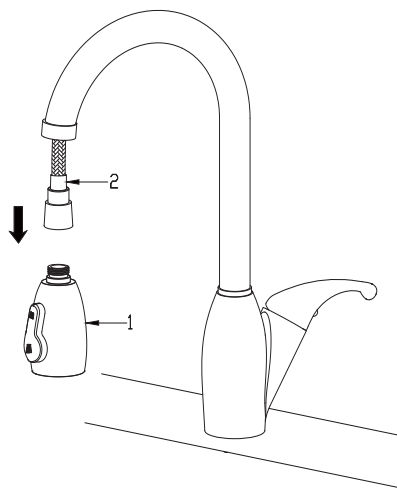
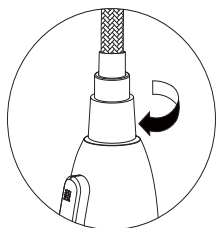
